

COMMISSIONER PROCEEDINGS

MARCH 19, 2018

GRANT, NEBRASKA

The regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners of Perkins County, Nebraska, was held at 8:30 a.m. in the County Courthouse in Grant, Nebraska.

Present: Commissioners Sid Colson, Bernard Deaver, Steve Tucker, County Attorney Richard Roberts, and Clerk Rita Long.

Chairman Colson called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. It was announced that notice of this meeting had been published in the Grant Tribune-Sentinel on March 14, 2018. Chairman announced the location of the Open Meetings Act Poster in the Commissioner’s Room. Commissioner Deaver made the motion to approve the minutes of March 5, 2018, meeting as published in the Grant Tribune-Sentinel. Commissioner Tucker seconded, roll call vote, 3 ayes, motion carried. The agenda was reviewed. Motion was made by Commissioner Tucker to approve the continuing agenda, seconded by Commissioner Deaver, roll call vote, 3 ayes, motion carried.

8:40 a.m. Fair Board members were present to discuss improvements to the Fairgrounds. Spokespersons Darin Jensen and Kasey Kroeker discussed specific improvements that need to be made.

Commissioner Deaver made the motion to allow \$156,000 from Inheritance Tax to the fair board to make improvements starting immediately and finish no later than 2019. This will be paid back to Inheritance Fund over the next 20 years. Commissioner Tucker seconded the motion, roll call vote, 3 ayes, motion carried.

Commissioner Deaver moved to sign the interlocal agreement with Dundy and Chase County for updating the tri-county Hazard Mitigation Plan and have the chairman sign. Commissioner Tucker seconded the motion, roll call vote, 3 ayes, motion carried.

Commissioner Tucker moved to sign the Axon agreement and have Commissioner Colson sign. Commissioner Deaver seconded the motion, roll call vote, 3 ayes, motion carried.

Julie Sestak requested transfer of funds. Commissioner Tucker moved to adopt Resolution 2018-12 to transfer from County General Fund to Paving, Commissioner Deaver seconded, roll call vote, 3 ayes, Resolution Adopted.
