The regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners of Perkins County, Nebraska, was held at 8:30 a.m. in the County Courthouse in Grant, Nebraska.

Present: Commissioners Sid Colson, Bernard Deaver, Steve Tucker, County Attorney Richard Roberts, and Clerk Rita Long.

Highway/Noxious Weed Superintendent Mike Dolezal was not present, but submitted a written report.

Commissioner Deaver moved to write-off the uncollectable accounts for the Perkins County Ambulance, Commissioner Tucker seconded the motion, roll call vote, 3 ayes, motion carried.

Unfinished Business:

Commissioner Tucker will be purchasing the Mower and Swing Arm from Regier Equipment for District 3.

New Business:

Commissioner Tucker moved to approve and have Chairman sign the Annual Certification for the Volunteer Emergency Responders Incentive Act for 2016 and 2017 for those who qualify.

Commissioner Deaver seconded the motion, roll call vote, 3 ayes, motion carried.

County Attorney Rick Roberts was asked about writing a request for a reconveyance from an SWNCBC loan. This will be on a future meeting.

Commissioner Deaver moved to accept the letter of resignation from Joe Krajewski on the Southwest Nebraska Resource Conservation and Development (Southwest Nebraska RC&D).

Commissioner Tucker seconded the motion, roll call vote, 3 ayes, motion carried.

Commissioner Deaver moved to authorize Amber Hilton to drive the Public Transit bus for Westview after receiving her authorized driving credentials. Commissioner Tucker seconded the motion, roll call vote, 3 ayes, motion carried.

Commissioner Tucker has been in contact with Benefit Management on the county's Health Insurance. There will be a decrease of 5.5% on the premium payments starting 3rd quarter if we chose to sign up for the decrease. The starting date for this decrease will be decided at a future meeting.
