Commissioner Deaver moved to adopt Resolution 2018-32 to transfer from the Transfer Ambulance to Ambulance to correct the budget from the fiscal year 2016-2017, Chairman Tucker seconded the motion, roll call vote, 3 ayes, Resolution Adopted.

Rita Long gave her report and fee reports.
