

BOARD OF EQUALIZATION PROCEEDING

OCTOBER 15, 2018

GRANT, NEBRASKA

The meeting of the Board of Equalization of Perkins County, Nebraska, was held at 9:30 a.m. in the County Courthouse in Grant, Nebraska.

Present: Steve Tucker, Sid Colson, Bernard Deaver, County Assessor Peggy Burton, County Attorney Rick Roberts and County Clerk Rita Long.

Chairman Colson called the meeting to order at 9:30 a.m. It was announced that the notice of this meeting had been published in the Grant Tribune-Sentinel on October 10, 2018. Chairman announced the location of the Open Meetings Act Poster in the Commissioner's Room. A motion was made by Commissioner Tucker to approve the minutes of July 16, 2018, as published in the Tribune-Sentinel, seconded by Commissioner Deaver, roll call vote, 3 ayes, motion carried.
