

BOARD OF EQUALIZATION PROCEEDING

APRIL 16, 2019

The meeting of the Board of Equalization of Perkins County, Nebraska, was held at 9:00 a.m. in the County Courthouse in Grant, Nebraska.

Present: Steve Tucker, Sid Colson, Ron Hagan, County Assessor Peggy Burton, County Attorney Rick Roberts and County Clerk Rita Long.

Chairman Tucker called the meeting to order at 9:03 a.m. It was announced that the notice of this meeting had been published in the Grant Tribune-Sentinel on April 10, 2019.
