This team member will lead or assist the PC Ambulance staff in providing sick and/or injured patient evaluation, treatment, and transportation for Perkins County in the pre-hospital, emergency setting. Candidates will be asked to operate in emergent, non-emergent and/or transfer situations at an advanced life support level, if necessary, until arrival at a definite care facility. Paramedics are to provide quality out of hospital care in a timely manner by safely assessing patients, performing advanced medical treatment to potentially avert life threatening emergencies and reduce morbidity; safely operate EMS vehicles including transporting patients to and from health care facilities; preparing and submitting reports; ensuring the stocking and safeguarding of vehicles, posts, equipment, supplies and medications. As the Ambulance Billing Administrator, candidates will be responsible for ambulance billing including Medicare billing and patient transfer billings.
