New Business:

Commissioner Tucker moved to adopt Resolution 2020-19 to deny the levy requests for all Political Subdivisions subject to allocation of property tax authority in Perkins County.

Commissioner Colson seconded, roll call vote, Hagan, abstain, Colson, yes, Tucker, yes, 2 ayes, 1 abstain, Resolution adopted. A copy of the Resolution will be sent to the Subdivisions.

Commissioner Hagan moved to adopt Resolution 2020-20 that the amount budgeted in the 2020-2021 fiscal year budget for “restricted funds” be increased by an additional one percent (1%), Commissioner Tucker seconded, roll call vote, 3 ayes, Resolution Adopted.

Commissioner Tucker discussed Perkins County Fair private donations.
