

COMMISSIONER PROCEEDINGS

NOVEMBER 2, 2020

GRANT, NEBRASKA

The regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners of Perkins County, Nebraska, was held at 8:30 a.m. in the County Courthouse in Grant, Nebraska.

Present: Commissioners Sid Colson, Ron Hagan, Steve Tucker, County Attorney Richard Roberts, and Clerk Rita Long.

Chairman Colson called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. It was announced that notice of this meeting had been published in the Grant Tribune-Sentinel on October 28, 2020. Chairman announced the location of the Open Meetings Act Publications in the District Court Room. Commissioner Hagan made the motion to approve the minutes of October 19, 2020, meeting as published in the Grant Tribune-Sentinel. Commissioner Tucker seconded, roll call vote, 3 ayes, motion carried. The agenda was reviewed. Motion was made by Commissioner Tucker to approve the continuing agenda, seconded by Commissioner Hagan, roll call vote, 3 ayes, motion carried.

New Business:

Commissioner Hagan moved to approve the Kenton Height Paving Project with Shelco Asphalt and Paving. Commissioner Tucker seconded the motion, roll call vote, 3 ayes, motion carried.

Commissioner Tucker moved to adopt Resolution 2020-30 to accept the amendment and addendum to NIRMA/NIRMA II Intergovernmental/Interlocal agreement. Commissioner Hagan seconded, roll call vote, 3 ayes, Resolution Adopted.

The motion was made by Commissioner Hagan to give Julie Sestak the registration of voting at the NACO December workshop with Stephanie Larson as the alternate designee. Commissioner Tucker seconded the motion, roll call vote, 3 ayes, motion carried.

Commissioner Tucker review the new health insurance rates for 2021. To stay with the same plan there will be an 6.49% increase in premiums. The Health Committee recommended staying with BCBS but to increase the HSA contribution from the county. Commissioner Tucker moved to approve the Health Committee recommendation with the employee paying 5% of the premium and to increase the HSA county contribution an additional \$50.00 per month (\$25.00 per pay period). Commissioner Hagan seconded the motion, roll call vote, 3 ayes, motion carried.
