Commissioner Colson moved to adopt Resolution 2021-05 that gives Vice Chairman Tucker authorization to sign the Resolution for Public Transportation Assistance program under Section 5311 of the Federal Transit Act and the Nebraska Public Transportation Assistance program for funds for the fiscal year 2021-2023. Commissioner Hagan seconded the motion, roll call vote, 3 ayes, resolution adopted. Commissioner Hagan moved to have the Vice-Chairman sign and approve the 5311 Funding Application for Public Transportation Operating Assistance. Commissioner Colson seconded the motion, roll call vote, 3 ayes, motion carried.
