The Board heard reports from Treasurer Julie Sestak, Extension Office Debbie Kuenning, Sheriff Jim Brueggeman, Transfer Ambulance Deanna Turner, Highway/Noxious Weed Superintendent Mike Dolezal, Building and Grounds Barb Baney, and County Clerk Rita Long, Julie Sestak requested transfer of funds. Commissioner Hagan moved to adopt Resolution 2022-30 to transfer funds from County General to Paving, Commissioner Colson seconded the motion, roll call vote, 3 ayes, Resolution Adopted.

Debbie Kuenning and Ben Dutton from UNL were present to discuss the Interlocal agreement with UNL and Perkins County.

Commissioner Colson moved to approve and have Chairman sign the interlocal agreement for law enforcement services with Arthur County starting January 5th, 2023 through April 21, 2023. Commissioner Hagan seconded the motion, roll call vote, 3 ayes, motion carried.

Commissioner Hagan moved to adopt Resolution 2022-31 to authorize an Interlocal agreement for Law Enforcement Services with Arthur County. Commissioner Colson seconded, roll call vote, 3 ayes, Resolution Adopted.

Commissioner Hagan moved to approve the sale/transfer of Glock Firearms to Law Enforcement Officers. Commissioner Colson seconded the motion, roll call vote, 3 ayes, motion carried.

County Clerk Rita Long gave her District Court fee report.

The Commissioners discussed Public Transit monthly reporting.
