Commissioner Bottom moved to adopt Resolution 2023-08 to sign the Resolution for Public Transportation Assistance program under Section 5311 of the Federal Transit Act and the Nebraska Public Transportation Assistance program for funds for the fiscal year 2023-2025. Commissioner Tucker seconded the motion, roll call vote, 3 ayes, resolution adopted.

Commissioner Bottom moved to sign and approve the 5311 Funding Application for Public Transportation Operating Assistance. Commissioner Tucker seconded the motion, roll call vote, 3 ayes, motion carried.

Commissioner Tucker made the motion to sign and approve the Title VI Non-Discrimination Plan 2023. Commissioner Bottom seconded the motion, roll call vote, 3 ayes motion carried.
