The meeting of the Board of Equalization of Perkins County, Nebraska, was held at 9:30 a.m. in the County Courthouse in Grant, Nebraska.

Present: Ron Hagan, Steve Tucker, Sid Colson, County Assessor Peggy Burton, County Attorney Rick Roberts and County Clerk Rita Long.
